

Open educational resources (OER) are documents and media useful for teaching, learning, educational, assessment and research purposes, made freely available online through open licenses such as Creative Commons. They include a varied range of digital assets from course materials, content modules and journals to digital images, music and videos, and represents an important cultural heritage not only from which to obtain resources but also to implement and improve.

Project partners have been jointly conducting a RESEARCH on good practices, case studies and examples on this topic. 37 websites offering language learning using OER were identified. The combined analysis report consists of an European review exploring the way in which support and guidance is available to adult language learners in case of self-directed learning when using web based OER.

Partners are using State of art report inputs to develop a methodology and a Guide on supporting L2 self-directed learning with web based OER.

Other IO will be two E-training courses based on the Guide (one addressed to L2 Learning Supporters and the other one to L2 learners), a website for supporting L2 self-directed learning.

All these results will be piloted from July 2016 to June 2017. In Italy, France and UK the pilot will involve 40 learners and 20 L2 Learning Supporters.
